IMPORTANT NOTES

Applicable EDIUS build / edition

Only EDIUS 11.50.20742 or later Broadcast edition supports Quick Fix Export feature. This feature is not available in both Workgroup and Pro editions. Visit EDIUS 11 [download page](#) to get the latest build.

Requirements

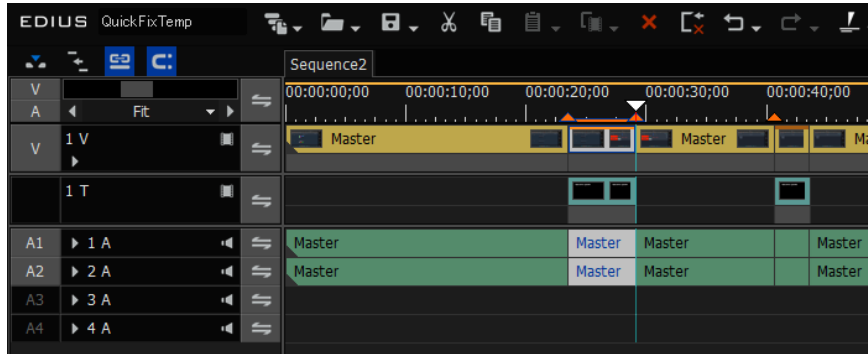
This operation involves making modifications on the timeline sequence used to create the completed full-length output file (the “full-length file”). Note the following points to use this feature.

1. Save the project used to create the full-length file before Quick Fix Export. If you are unsure whether the project has been saved, select **File > Save Project** to ensure it is saved.
2. The full-length file must have been created without using the “Display Timecode” and “Enable Conversion Processing” options. If either or both of these options were used when creating the file, Quick Fix Export cannot be performed.
3. Both the full-length file and the project used to create it must be accessible from EDIUS. However, if the location of the full-length file has been changed, you must manually specify the target file, exporter, and output destination when executing Quick Fix Export.

Launch Quick Fix Export

Modify required part

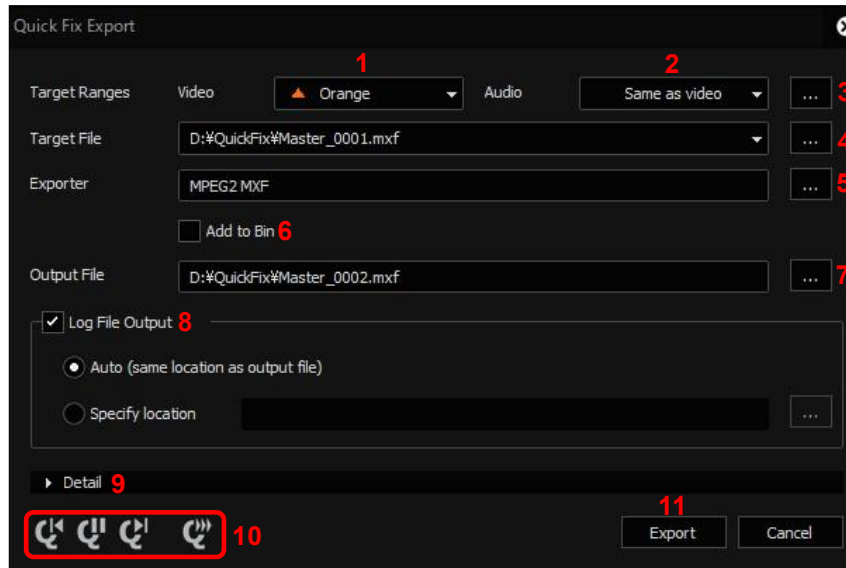
1. Open the timeline sequence of the project used to create the full-length file.
2. Modify required part on the timeline.
3. Move timeline cursor to revised start point then set In point of duration marker.
4. Whilst pressing Shift key and move the cursor to revised end point then set Out point of duration marker.



5. Repeat step#4 and #5 to set duration markers for all revised part.
* You can add a comment to duration marker if necessary.

Complete a modified final deliverable

1. Click Export button then select [Quick Fix Export].
2. Quick Fix Export dialog will appear. See below matrix to know each setting.



#	Description
1	Select revise part marker color – video part.
2	Select launch re-encoding audio track. If unnecessary, select None from drop-down list.
3	If you need to re-encode specific audio track, click the button and select target track.
4	Select final deliverable file (before revising).

5	Select exporter for modifying the file. If you select an exporter that does not support segment encoding, full-length encoding will run.
6	Tick the option to register revised file into the Bin.
7	Select destination and file name.
8	Re-encoding part is logged by ticking the option.
9	If any error, warning is detected, expand here to know error or warning in detail.
10	Preview revised part.
11	Launch Quick Fix Export.

3. Click [Export].

Verify the applied modifications

To review the modifications before launching Quick Fix Export, use the preview control buttons shown in the Quick Fix Export dialog to confirm the changes.



1	Move to previous marker.
2	Playback / Stop.
3	Move to next marker.
4	Plays back only the edited section repeatedly. The button turns blue during playback. Click again to cancel continuous playback.

Verify modified section

You can verify whether EDIUS created correct modified final deliverable file (the “modified file”). Take either way below to mount the modified file to Player.

1. Register modified file into the Bin then mount it onto Player.
2. Select [Job] tab or GV Job Monitor then right-click on Quick Fix Export job then select [Show in Player] context menu.

Once mounted, follow the steps below

1. Select **Clip > Quick Fix Export (Player) > Confirmation mode** (or **Confirmation preview**).
2. Behavior depends on selected menu. See below matrix:

Selected Mode	Behavior
Confirmation mode	Duration markers are shown at the modified sections and listed accordingly. Use the control buttons in the Player window for playback.
Confirmation preview	Along with the Confirmation mode operation, EDIUS plays only modified sections.

NOTE:

1. Due to the export process, duration markers may also appear near the beginning and end of the modified file.

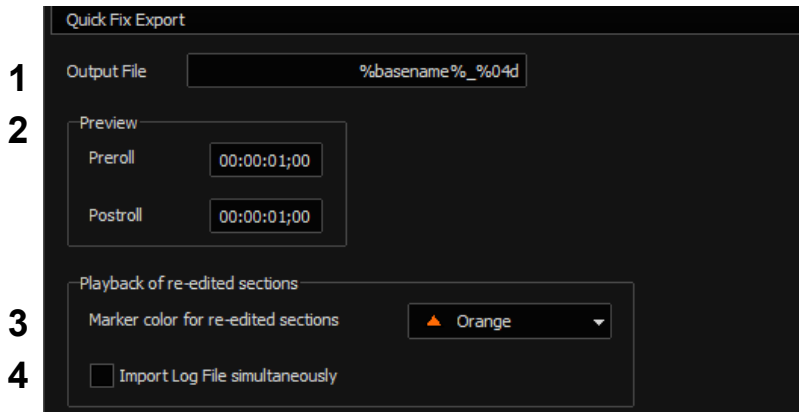


2. While Confirmation mode is enabled, operations on tabs other than [Clip Marker], Information window, and the menu bar are disabled. Once you have finished verifying the modified sections, exit Confirmation mode.

3. Once the verification completed, select **Clip > Quick Fix Export (Player) > Confirmation mode** (or **Confirmation preview**) to exit confirmation mode.

Configure Quick Fix Export settings

Select **Settings > User Settings > Application > Quick Fix Export** to configure the settings for Quick Fix Export.

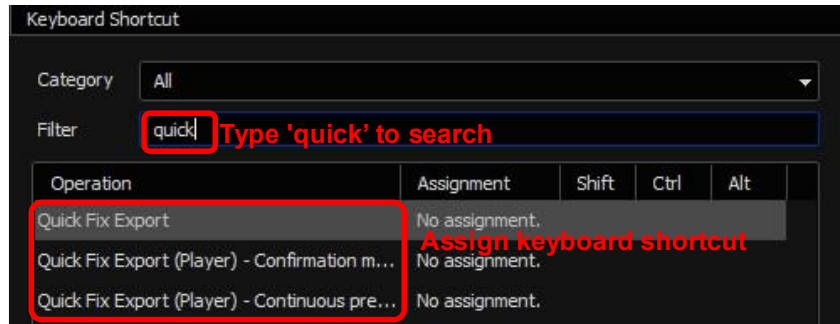


#	Description
1	Set modified output file name. The default format is as below: Sequential file name that starts from {Full-length output file}_0001
2	Set Preroll and Postroll value for Quick Fix Export
3	Select a color that does not overlap with the colors used during the editing.
4	If the option is ticked, when a comment is entered for a duration marker, it is displayed in the marker list.

Customize EDIUS UI

Assign keyboard shortcut

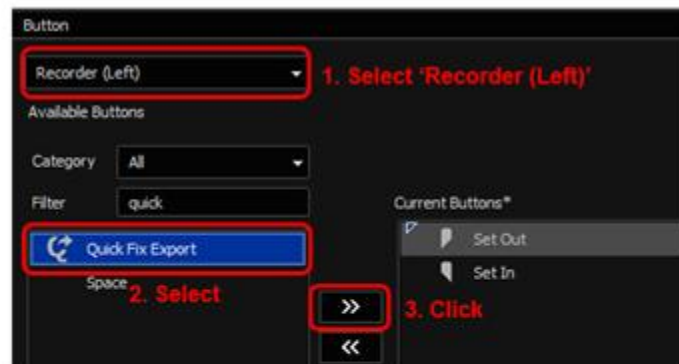
Select **Settings > User Settings > User Interface > Keyboard Shortcut** to assign keyboard shortcut for Quick Fix Export.



Show Quick Fix Export button on the recorder window

Follow the steps below to be available of Quick Fix Export button on the recorder window:

1. Select **Settings > User Settings > User Interface > Button**.
2. Activate Quick Fix Export button then click [Apply] > [OK].
3. Quick Fix Export button appears at selected position of Recorder window.



Show Quick Fix Export confirmation buttons on the player window

Follow the steps below to be available of Quick Fix Export button on the preview window:

1. Select **Settings > User Settings > User Interface > Button**.
2. Activate Quick Fix Export confirmation mode and continuous preview buttons then click [Apply] > [OK].
3. Registered buttons appear at selected position of Player window.
