To obtain the latest build of EDIUS 11 installer, applicable installer depends on the EDIUS edition and license type. Use correct download link in the download page on both EDIUS 11 and Chorus Hub server

NOTE: If inapplicable installer is downloaded and used, EDIUS will fail to run

Windows Defender SmartScreen blocking install

EDIUS All Installers

If Windows Defender SmartScreen prevents the installer from starting, please follow the following steps.

- 1) Right-click the installer file then select "Properties"
- 2) Open "Digital Signatures" tab then make sure the file has the digital signature of "GRASS VALLEY K.K."
- 3) Open "General" tab then check [Unblock] checkbox
- 4) Click [Apply] button, then click [OK] button
- 5) Run the installer again

Using with Floating License

Chorus Hub eco system

If Floating License Server is being used, its version has to be the same (or upper) as EDIUS 11.

Using with virtual machines

EDIUS 11 Cloud

When building a client on virtual machine by duplicating another virtual machine image, follow the below steps to run EDIUS on built machine:

- 1) Run Command Prompt with 'Run as administrator'
- 2) Navigate to **C:\Program Files\Grass Valley\EDIUS Hub.**
- 3) Run **SelfCertificationInstaller.exe**
- 4) Restart the OS

**Only EDIUS Cloud supports use with virtual machines in cloud environments such as AWS*

System Requirements

Optical Drive	For burning a media, separate authoring option and a burner corresponding to the media you want to create is required.

Installation Steps

Follow below steps to install the EDIUS – details [here](#)

- 1) Create eID (excl. Broadcast edition and OEM license)
- 2) Install EDIUS
- 3) Run EDIUS (incl. license activation and link to eID)

IMPORTANT NOTE

Grass Valley recommend to create eID before running EDIUS installer. Because you will be able to make sure that your PC has required accessibility to eID by taking step#1. This accessibility is required in step#3 for linking to eID.

Restrictions several QuickTime files

EDIUS 11 Client

Chorus Hub Ext. Render

From EDIUS X (incl. Mync Version 10.xx) or later, QuickTime modules are no longer used even though installing QuickTime Essentials. As the result, the following file formats are no longer supported:

- Still Image File Formats: Flash Pix; Mac Pict; QuickTime Image
- Video File Formats (Import / Export): M4V or some MOV file formats
**MOV files whose video formats are general ones such as MPEG-2, H.264/AVC, ProRes, etc. are able to be imported / exported*
- Video File Formats (Export): 3GP (MOV); 3G2 (MOV)
- Audio File Formats: MOV (other than Linear PCM and AAC); QuickTime Audio

IMPORTANT NOTE

There is no way to import the kind of file. Convert to supported format in advance. Use a third party conversion software. Grass Valley do not provide a conversion utility.

Notes on upgrading to EDIUS 11

Ten things to consider before you upgrade to EDIUS 11 from earlier version:

1. System Requirements

Ensure that your PC satisfies the [system requirements](#) of EDIUS 11.

2. Simultaneous installation of different versions

EDIUS 11 does not allow simultaneous installation of different EDIUS versions. If another version is being installed, uninstall it before running the EDIUS 11 installer – details [here](#)

3. Video Editing Hardware

- Storm 3G RS-422 remote control is no longer supported.
- For details of tested third party video hardware, visit EDIUSWorld.com

4. Third-party Plugin Software

EDIUS 11 does not support the third-party plug-in software designed for previous versions of EDIUS.

5. Obsolete of stereoscopic editing mode

Stereoscopic editing mode is no longer available in project settings.

6. Obsolete of multiple destination exporter

File exporter that sends to multiple destinations is no longer available. Below are applicable exporters:

- AVCHD 3D
- AVCHD 3D Writer
- AVCHD (Dual Card 3D) Writer
- MPEG Elementary Stream

7. Project File Compatibility

- EDIUS 11 is forwards-compatible with project files created with '-1' earlier version of EDIUS. However, third-party filter effects or titles may not be imported. Dummy effects will be applied in these cases.
- Earlier version of EDIUS does not support backwards-compatible with project files created with EDIUS 11.

- If you open stereoscopic project that is created by earlier version of EDIUS, EDIUS 11 only loads a clip that is equivalent to L side.

8. Blu-ray disc / DVD authoring

Separate option license is required to burn Blu-ray disc / DVD.

9. Using Upgrade / Jump Upgrade license

- 1) If purchased license is Upgrade or Jump Upgrade, you will be required to activate both EDIUS 11 and earlier version. Do NOT deactivate earlier version's license after completing license activation. GV License Manager validates both 'Upgrade' or 'Jump Upgrade' and earlier version's licenses. If earlier version's license would be deactivated, "Invalid license" will appear – for more details, click [here](#)
- 2) Remaining copy of earlier version cannot be used in another PC.
- 3) Both upgrade license (Upgrade or Jump Upgrade) and earlier version of EDIUS must be linked to same eID. You are not allowed to link each EDIUS license to different eID. If you no longer to use current eID (you would like to replace to another eID), contact to GV technical support along with below information:
 - eID currently used
 - Replacement eID
 - EDIUS serial numbers – both older version and Upgrade (Jump Upgrade)

NOTE: #3 is not applied to Broadcast edition and the OEM license.

10. Internet connection

'Pro' & 'Workgroup' require internet connection for periodical online validation of the license and eID (EDIUS ID). See [here](#) more details.

11. Mync Storyboard

EDIUS 11 bundled Mync does not have Storyboard function. If you want to use Storyboard function, deselect remove earlier Mync option while EDIUS 11 installation.

Assignable render job to the external client

Chorus Hub Ext. Render

Timeline export job can be assigned to external render client that is working on Chorus Hub eco system. This provides benefit of decreasing EDIUS client's load.

Below jobs are unable to be assigned to the external client. EDIUS client proceeds them:

- File conversion that runs in the Bin
- Timeline partial rendering – use [Render] menu
- Clip rendering – use [Render] menu
- Waveform cache creation
- EDIUS Proxy creation

License Issues Tips

Steps to activate / deactivate the license

Required step depends on EDIUS usage mode. For details, use the link in below matrix:

Use Pro / Workgroup edition in offline mode

EDIUS 11 Client

EDIUS Pro and Workgroup (excl. OEM license of both editions) also require a link to the eID when first time starting of EDIUS. For linking to eID, connect the client to internet. Because there is no way to link eID offline. Once the client is connected to internet, Grass Valley recommend to do both license activation and eID log in continuously. Ensure that successful of first time starting of EDIUS. Once verified, disconnect from internet. EDIUS will run in offline mode on subsequent running. You are allowed offline use for up to 30 days.

At 15 days after starting using EDIUS, you will receive a message that asks connecting to the Internet, please do the following within 15 days from the date the message was displayed.:

- 1) Quit EDIUS if running.
- 2) Connect the client to internet
- 3) Run the EDIUS

Once starting EDIUS successful, term of offline use successfully updated. Disconnect from internet. You can use the EDIUS in offline mode for next 30 days.

This design applies to below products - only Node Lock License, not applied to Floating License

- EDIUS 11 Pro (excl. OEM version)
- EDIUS 11 Workgroup (excl. OEM version)

About Node Lock License

A license that is activated on the EDIUS client PC (client). The license is registered in the license list of GV License Manager that is running on the client.

Use Broadcast edition & OEM in offline mode

EDIUS 11 Client

EDIUS Broadcast edition and OEM version of Pro / Workgroup allows permanent use in offline mode (you are not required periodical internet connection). Linking to eID is not available on these products - eID log in screen will not appear.

This design applies to below products:

- EDIUS 11 Pro OEM version
- EDIUS 11 Workgroup OEM version
- EDIUS 11 Broadcast

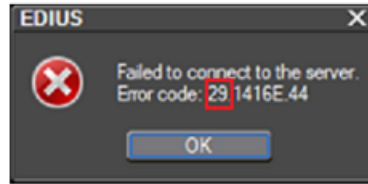
Likely causes are below. For details and resolution, click [here](#)

- Entered serial number format is invalid.
- Number or alphabet is not correct.

- A wide character (2-byte multilingual character code) is entered

An error occurs while license activation / deactivation

In appeared error dialog, see error code that is surrounded by red frame.

eID log in fails

If eID log in fails while starting EDIUS, text error message will appear. Likely causes and required action are vary depending on the error message – details [here](#)

If you encounter the issue, Grass Valley recommend confirming if you can visit eID web site in Microsoft Edge – see [Confirm accessible to the license server and eID website](#)

Configure Internet Properties

Grass Valley recommend to confirm that 'Use TLS 1.2' option is being activated in Internet Properties. Ensure that it is being activated before first time starting of EDIUS – details [here](#)

If you select offline activation / deactivation, ensure the settings on Windows PC that connects to internet.

Confirm accessible to the license server and eID website

If you encounter license issue, confirm accessible to the license server and eID website in the client:
