If Windows Defender SmartScreen prevents the installer from starting, please follow the following steps.

- 1) Right-click the installer file then select "Properties"
- 2) Open "Digital Signatures" tab then make sure the file has the digital signature of "GRASS VALLEY K.K."
- 3) Open "General" tab then check [Unlock] checkbox
- 4) Click [Apply] button, then click [OK] button
- 5) Run the installer again

New Features & fixed issues

New Features

This update provides the following additional features:

EDIUS

- To prevent accidental cancellation of an export, a confirmation dialog will now appear when the cancel button on the progress bar is pressed
- Supports displaying CEA-708 closed caption contains double-byte characters

Mync

Fixed or improved issues

The following issues are fixed or improved in this version:

EDIUS

- There is a possibility that EDIUS freezes when exporting if autosave takes a long time (SFDC00820653)
- When an effect settings dialog is maximized, some of key frames set in the dialog are not applied to rendered clips nor exported files (SFDC00824170)
- If a clip is transferred from removable media to project folder, file path of transferred clip is not changed (SFDC00824714)
- [OK] button on some filter settings dialogs is unable to be clicked if a vertical frame like 2160x3840 is set in the project settings
- A picture blinks if Mask filter is applied (SFDC00840058)
- Export with the XRE or GVRE fails if the export is started before completion of analysis of Stabilizer filter
- EDIUS crashes when a certain MP4 file is loaded (SFDC00849459)
- There is an operation that breaks the default exporter list when the current profile has been changed to read-only (SFDC00853186)
- EDIUS occasionally freezes when a growing clip is shown in the Player (SFDC00863170)
- EDIUS occasionally freezes if the combination of Tunnel Vision filter and Transform filter are applied
- EDIUS incorrectly handles the timecode of proxies shot by Sony cameras (SFDC00848752, 0084907)
- Footage corrupts in exported XAVC Long GOP files (SFDC00853652)
- Black frames appear randomly while playing the timeline with HEVC clips
- If a certain JPEG file is loaded, the image becomes black (SFDC00858876)
- File transcode with XRE or GVRE gives incorrect results if the target file is imported with one of certain types of third-party importers (SFDC00870083)
- K2 FTP source browser sends '\' (backslash) instead of '/' (slash) to the FTP servers (SFDC00867493)
- Occasionally render or export fails when the Mask filter is used (SFDC00872701)
- EDIUS misidentifies scan type for certain MP4 files (SFDC00879112)
- "Render and add to timeline" fails depending on the render format (SFDC00836174)
- Audio tracks in an MP4 file will be ignored if their start positions differ from the first audio track (SFDC00881472, 00882488, 00883536, 00888105)
- XRE Transcoder misidentifies color space of Final Cut Pro XML files
- If an I/O error occurs during reading a source file on export, there is possibility that a black part is inserted at the end of the exported file (SFDC00821867)
- Rarely an exported file has a frame whose lower field is black if progressive to interlaced conversion is done on export (SFDC00820151, 00824596, 00858871)
- When insert editing is done with an XDCAM deck as the recorder, black noise occasionally appears after the out point

Mync

- Black frames appear randomly while playing a storyboard with HEVC clips
- If a certain JPEG file is loaded, the image becomes black (SFDC00858876)
- Mync misidentifies scan type for certain MP4 files (SFDC00879112)
- If an I/O error occurs during reading a source file on export, there is possibility that a black part is inserted at the end of the exported file (SFDC00821867)
- Rarely an exported file has a frame whose lower field is black if progressive to interlaced conversion is done on export (SFDC00820151, 00824596, 00858871)

Design Limitations

Restrictions after uninstallation of QuickTime for Windows

In both EDIUS 9 and Mync, the following functionality will be lost if QuickTime is uninstalled:

- Still Image File Formats: Flash Pix; Mac Pict; QuickTime Image
- Video File Formats (Import / Export): M4V or some MOV file formats
**MOV files whose video formats are general ones such as MPEG-2, H.264/AVC, ProRes, etc. are able to be imported / exported*
- Video File Formats (Export): 3GP (MOV); 3G2 (MOV)
- Audio File Formats: MOV (other than Linear PCM and AAC); QuickTime Audio
